1. Introduction

Perspective VMS Version 3.x is the next generation platform of Video Management Software from LENSEC.

1.1. Scope

The trainings described/outlined herein are designed for certified LENSEC resellers and representatives. The general scope includes instruction on installation, configuration, and maintenance of Perspective VMS. Ancillary topics covered include configuration and setup of standard IP cameras and Windows Server/Workstation platforms.

2. Training Offerings

2.1. In-person Technical Training

2.2. Remote Technical Training

LENSEC offers custom technical training delivered via a web-based meeting platform several times a year. The focus is primarily on Perspective VMS operation and configuration. A general knowledge of IP networking, Windows-based Operating Systems, and Microsoft SQL database implementation is expected.

Live web-based training will be held on select aspects of Perspective VMS and/or Video Management in general. These sessions will assist in completion of LENSEC certification for technicians where travel may be prohibitive.
